

CANDLEWOOD SHORES TAX DISTRICT
ORDINANCE 1988-4
CONCERNING VEHICLES WITHIN THE
CANDLEWOOD SHORES TAX DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

Section 1 - SPEED LIMIT:

- A. The speed limit established and enforced by Town of Brookfield Police Department is 25 M.P.H. and should be observed at all times.

Section 2 - REGISTRATION:

- A. A valid state registration is required for all boats, vehicles and trailers belonging to residents and used on Candlewood Shores Tax District roads and its right of way.

Section 3 - PARKING RESTRICTIONS:

- A. No vehicle, boat trailer or RV, etc shall be parked on Tax District property unless it is a registered vehicle of a resident or authorized by the Candlewood Shores Tax District office.
- B. No vehicle, boat trailer or RV, etc shall be stored on Tax District property for more than thirty days per year unless it is a registered vehicle of a resident or authorized by the Candlewood Shores Tax District office.
- C. No person shall park any vehicle where parking is prohibited as indicated by appropriate signs and/or markings.
- D. No person shall park any vehicle within fifteen (15) feet of any fire hydrant.
- E. No person shall park any vehicle within twenty-five (25) feet of an intersection or stop sign.

- F. No person shall park any vehicle within the limits of any street in such a manner as to constitute a traffic hazard or to obstruct the free movement of traffic thereon, nor shall any person double park any vehicle.

- G. Any trailer or trailed equipment or non moveable device or object will not be permitted on any travel portion of Candlewood Shores Tax District roadways from 6 PM to 6 AM.

Section 4 - PARKING DURING STORMS:

- A. Speedy and efficient removal of snow from the streets is hereby declared to be vital to the public health and safety of all Candlewood Shores Tax District residents and guests.

- B. No person shall park any vehicle within the limits of any street during the time of falling snow, sleet or freezing rain or to obstruct or interfere with snow removal and/or sanding. This restriction applies until four (4) hours after the storm has ended.

Section 5 - UNREGISTERED VEHICLES ON CANDLEWOOD SHORES TAX DISTRICT ROADWAYS

- A. With the exception of handicap scooters, all unregistered vehicles including but not limited to any utility vehicle, golf car, ATV must be operated by a driver with a valid Motor vehicle operator's license.

- B. The vehicle operation is limited to daylight hours.

- C. The vehicle must be equipped with an operable horn and flag that is positioned to assist operators of motor vehicles in observing the location and operation of said unregistered vehicle.

- D. The vehicle may not transport more passengers than is recommended by the vehicle manufacturer at any given time.

Section 6 - VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES:

- A. The penalty for violation of any provision of this Ordinance, except speed limit violations and illegal parking during a storm, shall be a fine of Fifty dollars (\$50.00) per day.
- B. The penalty for violation of the prohibition against parking on streets during storms shall be a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per day.
- C. Whenever any vehicle is found parked in violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance, a Candlewood Shores Tax District agent shall attach to such vehicle a notice to the owner or operator thereof stating that such vehicle has been parked unlawfully.
- D. The owner of the Candlewood Shores Tax District residence shall be responsible for the parking violations of non resident guests and or tenants.
- E. There shall be a prima facie presumption that the owner of such vehicle was the person who parked such vehicle at the place where such violation occurred.
- F. Candlewood Shores Tax District may arrange to tow any vehicle which does not comply with the provisions of this Ordinance. The owner of such vehicle may reclaim such vehicle upon showing proper evidence of ownership and upon paying all towing and storage charges and fines.
- G. A separate offense shall be deemed committed upon each day during or which the violation occurs and continues.
